The Romans are condemned (including Imogen, Iacomo, and Posthumus).

Caius Lucius asks for Fidele's freedom.

Fidele asks why Giacomo wears Posthumus' ring.

Iacomo admits his lies about Imogen.

Posthumus reveals himself and confesses he ordered Imogen's death.

Posthumus hits Fidele for interrupting him.

Fidele is revealed as Imogen and is reunited with Posthumus

Pisanio tells the story of Cloten's journey to Wales.

Polydore and Cadwal admit to killing Cloten and Cybeline condemns them.

Belarius reveals his identity and confesses that Polydore & Cadwal are the king's sons.

Cymbeline is reunited with his lost sons and pardons Belarius.

Posthumus forgives Iacomo.

Cymbeline makes peace with Rome.
