MACBETH

- He is a Scottish lord, the Thane of Glamis.
- He owns a castle in Inverness, Scotland.
- He has no children.
- He is a brave fighter in King Duncan's army.
- King Duncan decides to reward Macbeth by giving him an additional title of Thane of Cawdor.
- Macbeth is visited by witches who tell him he will become Thane of Cawdor. They do this before Duncan's messenger reaches him with the same news.
- The witches also tell Macbeth he will become King.
